A professional strength d'limonene fortified stain, soil and spot remover for automotive applications. Dissolves tar, asphalt, grease and oil on contact. Ideal for use on auto exteriors as a pre-solve on splattered tar or asphalt prior to washing through a car wash or by hand. Also a great stain remover for auto upholstery, carpeting and floor mats. Water soluble for easy rinsing. Pleasant citrus fragrance.

Directions for Use

Exterior use: This product should be applied at full strength or diluted no more than 3:1 with warm water. Apply liberally to surface with a soft, clean cloth or sponge. Allow several minutes contact time to penetrate and dissolve soil. Agitate with cloth or sponge to facilitate removal. Wash or rinse car as usual. Heavy accumulations may require more than one cycle of application and rinsing.

Interior use: For carpeting, upholstery or floor mats, test product in an inconspicuous area to assure compatibility with material. Apply at full strength to stain. Blot stain with a clean cloth to remove excess. Do not wipe side to side, as smearing may result. Do not overwet. Clean fabric with an extraction carpet unit, or blot with clean water and absorb with a clean towel. Repeat as needed.
